This funding will be used to


- Ensure that, in 2017, 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 meet National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN (Reading, Writing & Numeracy) testing or meet the guaranteed standard as outlined in students' Individual Learning Guarantees.
- Improve teacher capability through the engagement of a Pedagogy / Curriculum Coach (0.3 FTE) to refine skills regarding the teaching of Numeracy and fostering collaborative teaching and planning of ACARA.
- Maintain the percentage of students in Year 3 & 5 in the upper two bands for Reading (35%) and Numeracy (30%).

Our initiatives include

- Monitor & review student performance and inform teaching using data from previous NAPLAN tests, CQ3S, PM, NCR & Early Start Diagnostic tests.
- Implement Intervention support programs implemented by teachers, administration and support staff.
- Resource a Support Teacher role to coordinate & implement Extension & Digital Technologies programs.
- Pedagogy Coach to work with teachers in areas of: alignment of ACARA in teaching in learning, support and feedback, effective teaching practices and Behaviour Management.

Engage 4 additional Teacher-Aides and provide additional teaching / planning time to develop, implement and support Reading & Numeracy Intervention Programs	\$75,000
Engage Pedagogy / Curriculum Coach (0.3 FTE) to mentor and work collaboratively with teachers	\$30,000
Participation in IMPACT online extension programs	\$10,000
TRS supporting Early Start (P-2 Literacy and Numeracy)	\$4590
