- Fund 0.4 FTE to engage a 14th classroom teacher to reduce multi-age classrooms to establish greater opportunity for collegial planning and streamlined implementation of the Australian Curriculum.
- Engage Support Teacher: Pedagogy (0.4FTE) improve teacher pedagogy through coaching and mentoring to support the effective and inclusive implementation of the Australian Curriculum by applying evidence-based High Yield Teaching Strategies (Frey, N., Hattie, J., Fisher, D. (2018). *Developing Assessment-Capable Visible Learners: Grades K-12*. CA: Corwin) and Mirani SS identified pedagogical practices.
